HIMGA Board Meeting February 9, 2022

Members present: Rich Rose, Jack Deaton, Wally Kratzer, Ernie Christian, Fred Neely

Called to order at 9:00 am

- 1. Treasurer's Report Rich Rose reported a current bank balance of \$5,586.64 plus a credit book balance of \$132.51 for a total of \$5,719.15 as of 01-31-2022 compared to \$5,393.45 for the same period in 2021.
- 2. Rich Rose presented the cashflow report for 2021. The league had revenue of \$4,170 and expenses of \$3,770 for a net increase in funds of \$400. He then presented a budget for 2022 which reflects income of \$3,803 and expenses of \$4,455 for a deficit of \$652. The main reason for the decrease in income is budgeting for only five new members versus the ten we had in 2021. The increase in expenses reflects the cost of a spring breakfast in 2022 and the purchase of golf balls. The board approved the budget.
- 3. Rich Rose reported that he contacted Golf Cars of NWA and they have expressed an interest in becoming a sponsor of HIMGA. He will continue to follow up with them.
- 4. It was suggested that the board review meeting minutes prior to posting on the website to ensure there are no suggested corrections.
- 5. Jack Deaton said he will start working on the HIMGA/HILGA golf tournament. He welcomes anyone who wants to assist with the tournament planning. The tournament is scheduled for May 14.
- 6. Rich Rose stated that he will have 2022 registration forms posted in HI Happenings thru the end of March.

No other business appearing the meeting was adjourned.
